February 20 - March 27: Stations of the Cross / Soup and Bread. The St. Aloysius' Knights of Columbus will be celebrating the Stations of the Cross during our Lenten Season. March 27th will be a Family & Children's Stations of the Cross with an interactive component for your youngest parishioners. Good Friday, April 3rd, will conclude our Lenten Journey through the Stations of the Cross.

April 2: Holy Thursday. Everyone gathered will have the opportunity to follow Christ's example of service and participate in the washing of the feet. Our ushers will guide pairs to the sanctuary steps and our OCIA Elect will assist you with the water and basins. Everyone will be invited, but not required to come forward.
