Knights of Columbus will have a meeting on April 11th in the parish hall.

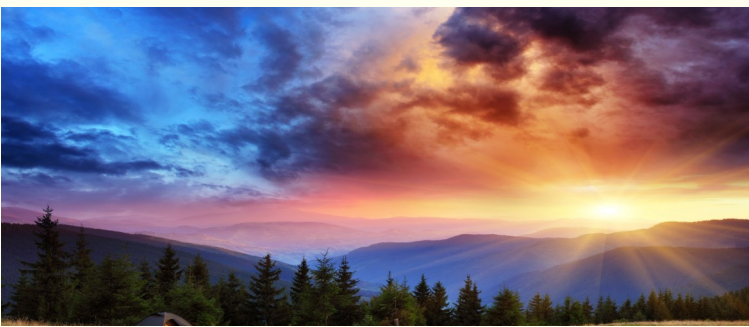
