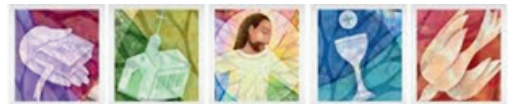

The concert will be **Sunday, April 19, at 3:00 p.m., at Saint John's Cathedral** (on Grand Avenue), and is part of the Spokane Chapter's 80th anniversary season. Although *Requiem* is a concert piece and not a liturgical one, it is profoundly infused with the sacred. **Divine Mercy Sunday
April 12, 2026**

St. Augustine parish will have a Holy Hour beginning at 2:30 PM with Eucharistic Adoration. The recitation of the Divine Mercy Chaplet will begin at 3 PM (the Hour of Great Mercy). The Chaplet of Divine Mercy is a Catholic prayer for mercy and atonement, revealed to St. Faustina in the 1930s, that uses rosary beads to ask for God’s grace for the world. It is central to Divine Mercy Sunday which celebrates God's love and offers plenary indulgence which is a special grace that removes all temporal punishment due to sins already forgiven, acting as a complete cleansing of the soul.
