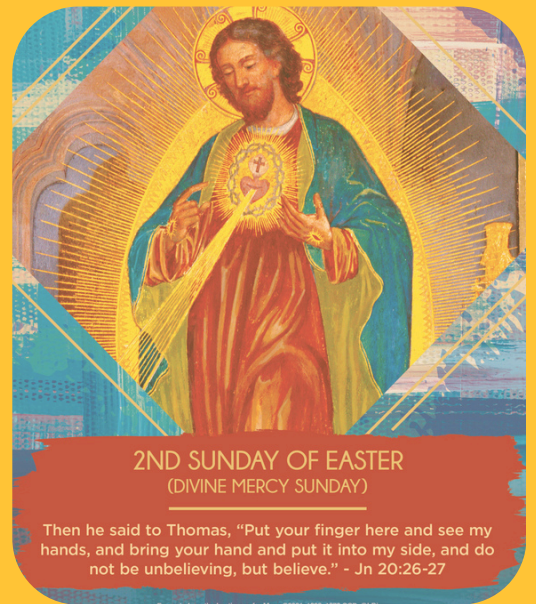

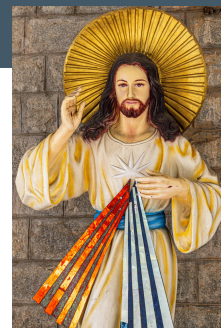

To inspire in each other a longing for holiness, conversion, and an openness to Jesus' call: "Follow Me;" by giving ourselves entirely to Christ through Mary, our Mother, in prayer, the Divine Liturgy, the Eucharist, and His Mercy in the Sacraments.



Divine Mercy Sunday

Jesus appeared to the young saint clothed in a white garment with His right hand raised in the posture of giving a blessing and His left covering the area of His Heart. From the Heart, two large rays beamed, one red and the other a pale white. Jesus said to her:

"Paint an image according to the pattern you see, with the signature: Jesus, I trust in You. I promise that the soul that will venerate this image will not perish. I also promise victory over [its] enemies already here on earth, especially at the hour of death. I Myself will defend it as My own glory (Diary, 47, 48). I am offering people a vessel with which they are to keep coming for graces to the fountain of mercy. That vessel is this image with the signature: Jesus, I trust in You (327). I desire that this image be venerated, first in your chapel, and [then] throughout the world (47)."

The two rays express Blood and Water. His tender mercy. The same Blood and Water which gushed forth from the side of Christ as he was pierced on the Cross. St Faustina asked the Lord the meaning of the rays in the image to which he expressed this and also reminded us that ***"the demands of My mercy, because even the strongest faith is of no avail without works."*** indicating that the Image represents the graces of the Divine Mercy and reemphasizing the importance of Sacred Tradition together with Sacred Scripture.

In the year 2000, St Pope John Paul the II canonized St Faustina and at the same mass, instituted that the Second Sunday of Easter be the Sunday of the Divine Mercy. In His revelations to St Faustina, the Lord also requested that a special prayer and meditation be made every day at 3:00 PM, the hour that recalls His death on the Cross.

For the sake of Your Sorrowful Passion, Jesus have mercy on us! Happy Divine Mercy Sunday!
