MUSIC CORNER

Recently, I was asked a question about what role Latin plays in the liturgy after Vatican II, particularly in regards to music. For the next six weeks, I will be presenting a series on Latin in the Liturgy, using the documents of Vatican II as sources. We begin with a strong statement: The Second Vatican Council did not intend to eliminate Latin from the liturgy, but rather to renew the Church's worship while preserving its heritage. In Sacrosanctum Concilium, the Council Fathers explicitly state that "the use of the Latin language is to be preserved in the Roman rites," even as they permit a broader use of the vernacular for the sake of pastoral effectiveness. This establishes a foundational principle: Latin remains normative, while the vernacular is a pastoral accommodation. Any discussion of liturgical music, therefore, must begin with the understanding that Latin is not a relic of the past, but an enduring element of the Roman Rite.

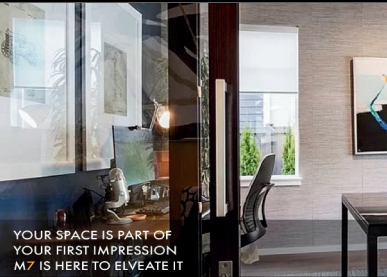

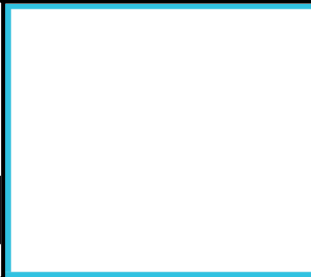
