### The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy

Complementary to the Eucharistic theme in today's Gospel, the two prelude pieces are settings of the African-American spiritual *Let us Break Bread Together*. The composers are Dale Wood (1934-2003) and Charles Callahan (b. 1951). The postlude, *Toccata on "O filii et filiae"* by Alfred Fedak (b. 1953), uses the 15th-century Easter hymn of the same title as its basis. The hymn, with text by Franciscan friar Jean Tisserand (d. 1497), recounts the entire Easter story, from the discovery of the empty tomb to Thomas's acknowledgement of the risen Christ.
