The first reading from the Acts of the Apostles reads

“Repent and be Baptized, each and every one of you for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit”

“Christian initiation is accomplished by three sacraments together: Baptism which is the beginning of new life; confirmation which is its strengthening; and the Eucharist which nourishes the disciple with Christ’s Body and Blood for his transformation in Christ”

CCCC 1275

Baptism initiates us into being God’s sons and daughters. Of the seven sacraments, there are three sacraments of Initiation – Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist. Baptism gives us new life in Christ. We must recognize that this new life is a complete and total gift from our Lord, nothing that we as humans have done to be brought into the kingdom of light.

“According to the Church’s command, ‘after having attained the age of discretion, each of the faithful is bound by an obligation faithfully to confess serious sins at least once a year.’ Anyone who is aware of having committed a mortal sin must not receive Holy Communion, even if he experiences deep contrition, without having first received sacramental absolution”

CCCC 1457

As Catholics, we must repent! It is clearly stated in the Catechism of the Catholic Church that as practicing Catholics, we must receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation *at least* once a year. Confession is a sacrament of healing and is also such a gift from our Loving Father. He desires good for us so much so that he has instituted this sacrament so that we can continue to turn to Him and to continue to trust in His Sacred Heart. So if you have not been to Confession in the last year, I encourage you to do so. Turn to the Father in His Mercy that He gives so freely.
