The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy

Dom Paul Benoit, O.S.B (1893-1979) was a Benedictine monk, organist, and composer. Among his many works is today's prelude, *Le Bon Pasteur* (The Good Shepherd), written for Good Shepherd Sunday, the Fourth Sunday of Easter. 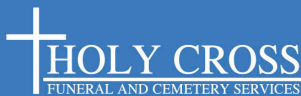
