FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

Pastor's Corner —My brothers and sisters in Christ, May the Lord continue to bless our families and our parish community!

On this Fourth Sunday of Easter, the Church invites us to reflect on one of the most comforting images in all of Scripture: Jesus as the Good Shepherd. In today's Gospel, Jesus tells us, "My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me." These words remind us of the deep, personal relationship that God desires to have with each one of us. The image of the Good Shepherd speaks of care, protection, and unwavering love. A shepherd knows each of his sheep by name, leads them to safety, and never abandons them. In the same way, Jesus knows us intimately—our joys, our struggles, our fears, and our hopes. He walks with us, guides us, and calls us to trust in His loving care.

Yet, in the midst of the many voices in our world today, it can be difficult to recognize the voice of the Shepherd. We are surrounded by noise, distractions, and pressures that can pull us away from God. That is why it is so important to take time for prayer, to listen in silence, and to remain close to Him through the Scriptures and the Eucharist. The more we listen, the more we learn to recognize His voice.

This Sunday is also a special day to pray for vocations to the priesthood and religious life. The Church continues the mission of the Good Shepherd through those who dedicate their lives to serving God and His people. Let us pray that many hearts will respond generously to the Lord's call, and that our young people may have the courage to follow Him wherever He leads.

As parish communities of St. Joseph and St. Anthony in Spokane, we are also called to reflect the love of the Good Shepherd in our daily lives. We are invited to care for one another, to reach out to those who feel lost or forgotten, and to be instruments of God's compassion and mercy.

Let us ask the Lord for the grace to listen attentively to His voice, to follow Him faithfully, and to trust in His guidance, especially in times of uncertainty.

May we always find peace and security in the loving care of our Good Shepherd.

May God bless our Parish! May the Lord continue to provide us with deeper faith and love in the Eucharist!
