**The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy**

In honor of our Blessed Mother, the prelude and postlude music have a Marian theme. Today's prelude music consists of two settings of *Ave Maria*. In the first of these, Charles Gounod added a melody to Bach's *Prelude in C major* to give us this now-famous setting. The second is a setting of the Gregorian chant for *Ave Maria* by American composer Gerald Near. The postlude is the first Magnificat verset of a suite by Jean-François Dandrieu, originally composed for a practice called *alternatim* in which the organ would alternate with the sung verses of the *Magnificat*--Mary's song of exultation to her cousin Elizabeth. 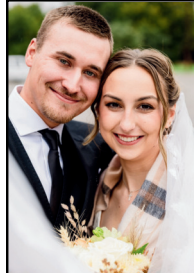
