May is a month devoted to the Blessed Virgin Mary

May has long been cherished in the Church as a month especially dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Mother of Jesus. This beautiful tradition stretches back many centuries, with roots as early as the Middle Ages and becoming more firmly established in the life of the Church by the 18th and 19th centuries. As spring brings new life and blossoms to the earth, the faithful have naturally turned their hearts to Mary, honoring her as the most perfect flower of God's creation.

Throughout the centuries, Catholics have found many meaningful ways to express their love and devotion to Our Lady. One of the most beloved customs is the creation of a May shrine, where flowers are placed before a statue or image of Mary as a sign of love, gratitude, and reverence. This simple yet profound act reminds us of the beauty of offering our hearts to God through her.

Many also take up the practice of praying the Rosary more intentionally during this month, meditating on the life of Christ through the eyes of His mother. Others participate in Marian processions, joyfully witnessing to their faith as they walk together in prayer and song. Another deeply enriching devotion is making a personal consecration to Mary, entrusting one's life to her care so as to be more perfectly united to the will of her Son, Jesus.

As a parish, we have a special reason to rejoice during this Marian month. We are blessed to have Our Lady of Fatima as our patroness—a powerful reminder of Mary's call to prayer, repentance, and trust in God. On her feast day, May 13th, we will also witness a beautiful moment in the life of our parish as our children receive Our Lord in First Holy Communion. What a fitting and grace-filled way to honor our Blessed Mother, who always leads us closer to her Son in the Holy Eucharist.

May this month be an invitation for each of us to grow in love for Mary, to follow her example of faith and humility, and to draw ever closer to Jesus through her gentle guidance.

MUSIC CORNER

The instruction Musicam Sacram develops these principles further by providing practical guidance for implementation. It emphasizes a graduated approach to sung liturgy, encouraging that the most important dialogues and acclamations—many of which may be sung in Latin—be prioritized. It also reaffirms that Latin should be retained, especially in sung celebrations, and that pastors should take care to ensure the faithful can participate in commonly sung Latin texts. This document makes clear that the Council’s vision is not theoretical, but meant to be lived out concretely in parish life.

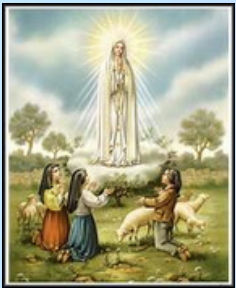


Join us in prayer for this month’s Papal intention!

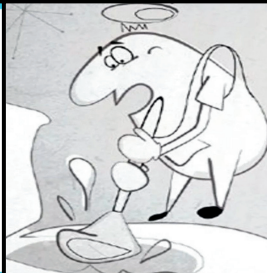
