## Happy Mother's Day

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday is Mother's Day. A time to reflect upon motherhood and honor our mothers. My mother passed away in 2009, but her influence is lasting especially on her eight children. She took her responsibility as a parent and mom seriously and did not concede or relegate to anyone her parental authority as a mom.

Our Church teaches that parents are the primary educators of their children and that family is the "domestic church." The domestic church means that parents are the first teachers of the faith to their children, for which, as St. Pope Paul VI said of the family, "there is no substitute."



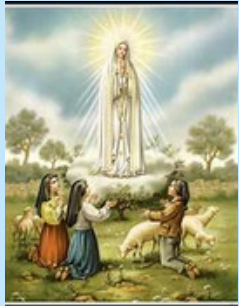
Government schools or even Catholic schools should never replace the God given right of parental authority in the education of their children. My mother understood this and did not even trust the Catholic school to give her children proper faith formation. My Mother, along with my father, were my first teachers of the faith. My father was a convert to Catholic faith due to the example of my Mother. My parents lived out their Catholic faith in both word and deed. They were always very active, supportive and involved in our parish.

My parents were very involved in the Cursillo moment in the 70's and this had a profound effect on their faith life and their relationship with Jesus. My mom started a women's prayer/study group in our home and for many years she helped many women grow in their Catholic faith. My dad was an active Knight of Columbus and supported pro-life causes. We put on my father's headstone "defender of the unborn."

It was my mother's faith that made our home a "Domestic Church." The liturgical seasons, Advent, Christmas, Lent, Holy Week and Easter we kept, made special, and celebrated in our home. My mom made the faith special and we knew how important God was in our family, especially on Sundays, the Lord's day. Sunday mass was a part of our family life, even on vacations and camping we always found a place to go to Mass. Sundays were days of rest, family time and suppers.

My mother had a very great devotion the Blessed Virgin Mary. We prayed the Rosary as a family. The Rosary was a dear and important prayer to my mother. When all the kids were gone my parents prayed the Rosary together as a couple until she died. My devotion to the rosary comes from my mother.

I thank God for motherhood and for the mother he gave me and we pray for all mothers on this Mother's Day that they can also have such a good influence on their children as my mother did for me.

On May 13, 1917, in a field called the Cova da Iria near Fatima, Portugal, three young shepherd children—Lucia dos Santos and her cousins Francisco Marto and Jacinta Marto—were tending their flock when they saw a brilliant light. In the midst of it appeared a beautiful Lady dressed in white, shining brighter than the sun. The Lady, later known as Our Lady of Fatima, spoke gently to the children, asking them to return to that place on the 13th of each month for the next six months. She invited them to pray the Rosary every day for peace in the world and an end to war, and to offer their prayers and sacrifices in reparation for sin.

Though initially afraid, the children were filled with peace by her presence. They promised to do what she asked, beginning a series of apparitions that would call the world to prayer, repentance, and trust in God.
