## PENTECOST SUNDAY

Pastor's Corner — My brothers and sisters in Christ, May the Lord continue to bless our families and our parish community!

This Sunday we celebrate the beautiful and powerful feast of Pentecost, the day when the Holy Spirit descended upon the apostles and filled them with courage, wisdom, and faith. Pentecost marks the birth of the Church and reminds us that we are never alone. The same Holy Spirit who guided the apostles continues to guide us today, strengthening us and leading us closer to God.

Before Pentecost, the apostles were filled with fear and uncertainty. They gathered together in prayer, unsure of what the future would hold.
