MUSIC CORNER

Today we have the privilege of hearing one of the three great sequences of the Easter Season. The first is sung on Easter Sunday - Victimae Paschali Laudes; the second on Pentecost - Veni Sancte Spiritus; and finally, the third is today on the Feast of Corpus Christi, the Most Holy Body and Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ - the Lauda Sion. The Lauda Sion was composed around 1264 by Thomas Aquinas at the request of Pope Urban IV when the feast was extended to the universal Church. The text is a poetic summary of Catholic Eucharistic doctrine, especially the Real Presence and transubstantiation, and quickly became one of the most treasured liturgical texts of the Middle Ages. After the reforms following the Council of Trent, it was retained as one of the few medieval sequences preserved in the Roman Missal, and it remains the traditional sequence for Corpus Christi today.
