Pastor's Corner — My brothers and sisters in Christ, May the Lord continue to bless our families and our parish community!

As we gather this Sunday to celebrate the **Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ**, we are invited into a mystery that is both ancient and breathtakingly new. In the heart of Spokane, amidst the beauty of our late spring, we stop to recognize that the Bread of Life is not just a symbol of our faith—it is the very heartbeat of our community.

In the readings for Year A, we are taken back to the wilderness with the Israelites. Moses reminds the people of how God fed them with manna, a food "which neither you nor your fathers had known." It was a lesson in radical dependence. Today, we often live in a "wilderness" of busyness, digital noise, and social isolation. Yet, the same God who provided in the desert provides for us now on the altars of our beloved parishes.

The Gospel of John brings this home with startling clarity: "**I am the living bread that came down from heaven.**" Jesus does not offer us a temporary fix for our hunger; He offers us His very self. When we receive the Eucharist, we are not just performing a ritual. We are being infused with the divine life of Christ. This is our "viaticum"—our food for the journey—strengthening us to be His hands and feet in our neighborhoods, from the historic streets near St. Anthony's to the quiet corners of St. Joseph's.

St. Paul reminds us in the second reading that because there is one loaf, we, though many, are one body. This is the "inspirational challenge" of Corpus Christi:

• **To See Christ in Others:** If we recognize Him in the Host, we must also recognize Him in the stranger, the lonely neighbor, and the suffering.

• **To Become What We Receive:** We consume the Bread of Life so that we might become bread for a hungry world. As we process today—whether physically with the Monstrance or spiritually in our hearts—let us carry the light of the Eucharist out of the church doors. Let your life be a "living monstrance." When you leave the pews today, remember that you carry a peace the world cannot give. May the Body and Blood of Christ heal our wounds, unite our two communities, and ignite in us a fire of charity that transforms Spokane.

May God bless our Parish! May the Lord continue to provide us with deeper faith and love in the Eucharist!
