This concert features musicians Irene Roldán of Basel, Switzerland, *harpsichordist* and Jeffrey Cohan of Washington State, *baroque flutist*.

Irene Roldán was honored with the prestigious Bach Prize and an additional special award at the XXXIII International Bach Competition held in Leipzig, Germany.

Since 2011, the Salish Sea Early Music Festival has presented world-class chamber music performances on period instruments, featuring acclaimed musicians from around the Puget Sound, the United States, Canada, and Europe.

Entrance is by donation and the concerts have always been open to all regardless of contribution.

O Desire of Nations and Center of History, we ask you to bless these United States of America.

Who live and reign with God the Father
in the unity of the Holy Spirit,
God, for ever and ever.

The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy

"Tis so sweet to trust in Jesus, just to take Him at His Word

Just to rest upon His promise, just to know, "Thus saith the Lord."

*"My hope is built on nothing less
Than Jesus's blood and righteousness..."*

These words are taken from the two American hymn tunes which form the basis for today's prelude music: "'Tis So Sweet to Trust in Jesus," and "My Hope is Built on Nothing Less." Both settings are by American composer Emma Lou Diemer (1927-2024), and the hymns complement the theme of today's Epistle. The postlude is a chorale prelude by German Baroque composer Johann Pachelbel (1653-1706) based upon the famous melody for Psalm 100.
