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Sunday Reflection

This week you can say is a continuation or a part two of Gods Mission statement for his 12 apostles, yet more importantly us. Last week we read about Jesus as the Compassionate Sheppard who is moved to pity for those that are troubled and abandoned and for us as followers of Christ to act as he did. As Father Raymond mentioned so perfectly, God calls us to carry his mercy into the world, He heals us so we can become healers, he loves us so we can be instruments of his love, the harvest is plentiful, yet the laborers are few.

Jesus is calling us just as he did with his apostles to be laborers for his harvest, yet now the part 2. Its not going to be easy!

As we journey out bringing the Gospel to others, helping others, there will be times that we encounter fear. Fear of what others may think, fear of standing out and being different. We witness this and experience this each day, we see and feel the reaction or pushback received from a society that a lot of time either just doesn't understand or people do and chose not to care or show disrespect especially when it comes to our Catholic Faith and beliefs. Like the way we defend the sanctity of life from conception to natural death, the times that we choose to be bold and make the sign of the cross before meals publicly, those times that we hold out a rosary and pray for Mary to intercede for us.

In the face of fear or doubt or uncertainty we as disciples sent by God must remain steadfast, continue to be labors , continue to be Christ like to others without fear and having the reassurance that God is with us and we must always trust in him Jesus I trust in you.

God knows you, sees what your doing and knows the sacrifices that you make as his followers. As it says in

the todays Gospel "*Everyone who acknowledges me before others, I will acknowledge before my Father but whoever denies me before others I will deny before my heavenly Father.*"

The next time fear or doubt try to takeover, remember that being faithful to Christ and being his bold and brave disciples wherever we are needed is much more important then fear or loss or rejections by others. Trust in Gods presence, Speak boldly, and choose your side, choose Christ! If Christ was willing to die for us and obtain our salvation, the least we can do is be his voice, to bring his compassion and to show his mercy.

Saint Mother Teresa gave a great example to follow. One day a volunteer became discouraged because nobody seemed to appreciate the difficult work they were doing among the poor Mother Teresa smiled and said "*God has not called us to be successful, he has called us to be faithful*"

May we always be the 12 called disciples and go forth and not be afraid, but be empowered by the knowledge that we are known, loved by God.

I would like to share this beautiful prayer I found that addresses any fears we might have on our journey. Merciful Jesus, when fear rises within me, let your words echo within me each day:

"do not let your heart be troubled. let your truth be my strength, my refuge, my peace, my living hope. When my journey is complete, bring me to the place you have prepared for me where there is no fear, no sorrow, no trouble only everlasting peace of your presence. For you are my peace , my hope and my eternal rest. Jesus I place all my trust in you, all my hope is in your mercy"

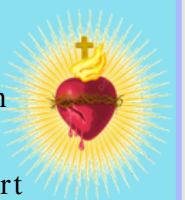
Pro-Life Rosary
