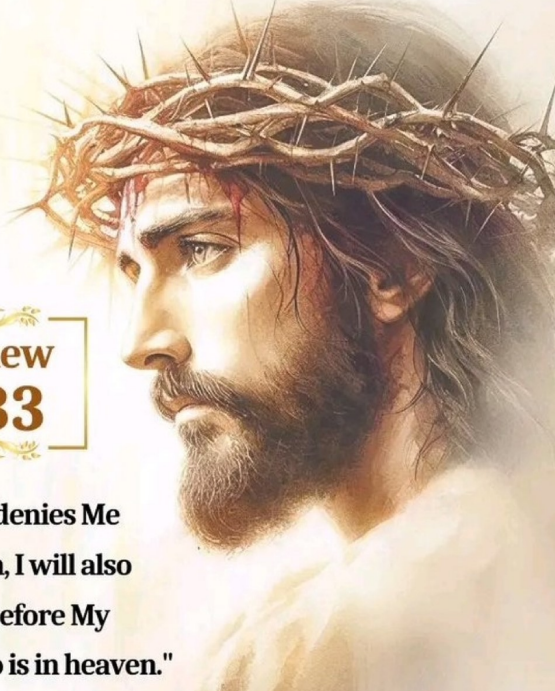

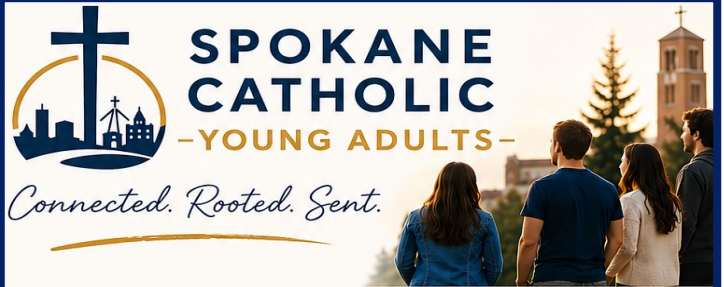

Dear Parishioners,

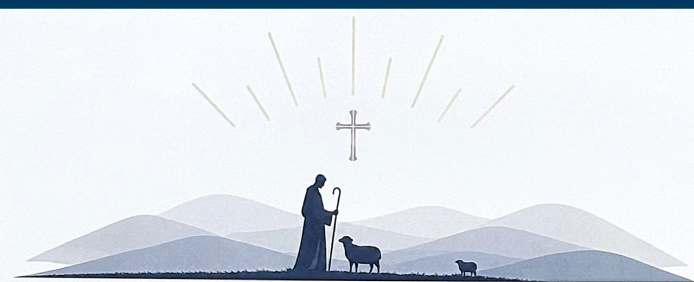

SEMINARIAN FORMATION APPEAL • 2026

We are blessed beyond words to have 19 men the path to priesthood, hoping to someday bring the hope of the Gospel to hearts that are restless and seeking God at a deeper level.

The path to priesthood is lengthy. Formation can be nine years for a seminarian who begins at Cor Christi, continues his college studies at Bishop White Seminary and finishes his theological studies at Mount Angel Seminary in St. Benedict, Oregon, St. Patrick's Seminary in Menlo Park, California or St. Francis de Sales Seminary in Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

The cost to form a seminarian over a nine-year period can exceed \$400,000. Although the Annual Catholic Appeal contributes a substantial amount to the cost of formation, additional funding is needed. That is why the Seminarian Formation Appeal was created three years ago. Parishioners should have received a mailing from Bishop Daly during the week of June 8th with information about this collection.
