CELEBRATING FATHERS AND THE HOLY TRINITY

Dear Parishioners,

The Catholic Church teaches that the family is the basic cell of society, and there is no substitute for it. The family is a sign and reflection of the Trinity. The Trinity is a communion of love, with each Person having an identity and role. In the same way, the family is a community of love in which each member has an identity and role: father, mother, and children.

Today is Father's Day, a time when we honor fathers. Our society has often marginalized and sidelined the role of fatherhood and what it means to be a man. Men and masculinity have even been labeled as "toxic." Yet our Catholic tradition honors the role of the man and the father. Drawing from the mystery of the Trinity, the Father is the Divine Creator, Maker, and Craftsman, and the Son proceeds eternally from the Father. St. Joseph serves as the human model of manhood and fatherhood. He was called to be the foster father of Jesus and the husband of Mary. Joseph was the provider and protector of the Holy Family and an essential part of the communion of love within that family.

Fathers, and indeed all men, are called to be fruitful, to provide for life, and to protect it. This vocation is seen most clearly within the family. A man and a father do not live for themselves, but for others.

Today, as we celebrate Father's Day, we honor all fathers and pray that all men may discover their God-given roles and fully live out their vocations as fathers in whatever context God has called them.

This week we are exploring the origin of the word cantor. The word cantor comes from the Latin cantare, meaning "to sing," and cantor, meaning "singer." In the early Church, the cantor had the important role of leading the sung prayers and scriptural chants of the liturgy, helping the faithful participate more fully in worship. Today, the cantor continues this ancient ministry by serving as a musical leader who supports and encourages the congregation's singing rather than performing for them.
