The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy

*"Through Adam's fall, the human race was doomed to condemnation;
Bereft were we of innocence, sin's poison wrought destruction..."*

These words are taken from a German chorale whose theme can clearly be seen mirrored in today's Epistle. The setting is by the great German composer Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1750), and is included in his Orgelbüchlein, a collection of chorale preludes for the Liturgical Year. The slow tempo, the angular bass part, and the chromatic harmonies are meant to portray the anguish that sin has brought to our human condition. The postlude, also by Bach, is the third fugue from his monumental Prelude and Fugue in E-flat Major, and incorporates the hymn tune we sang today as our Entrance Hymn: O God, Our Help in Ages Past.

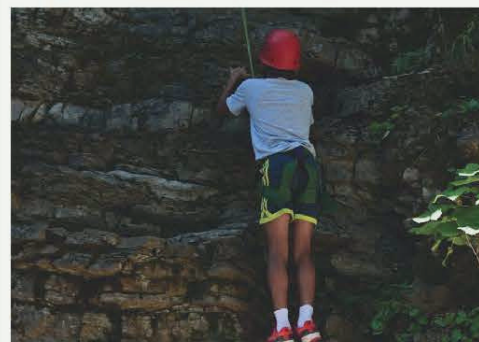
