

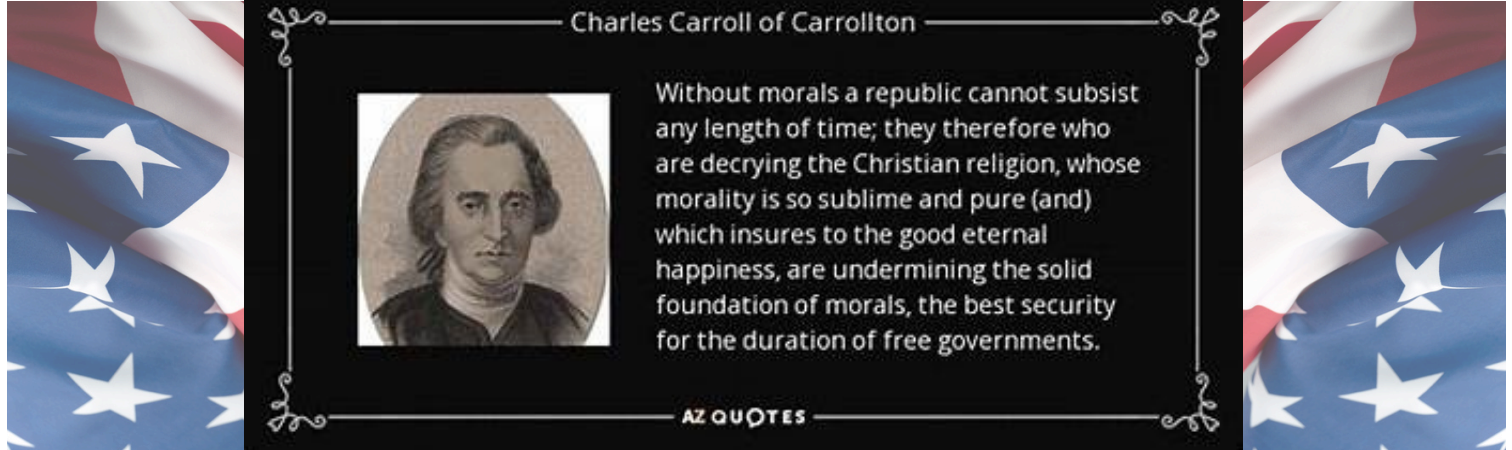

### AMERICA AT 250: A CATHOLIC REFLECTION

As our nation celebrates the 250th anniversary of the Declaration of Independence, it is fitting to remember the contributions Catholics have made to the history of the United States.

One of the most important Catholic figures of the founding era was Charles Carroll of Carrollton, the only Catholic signer of the Declaration of Independence. At a time when Catholics often faced discrimination and legal restrictions, Carroll's public support for independence helped demonstrate that Catholics were committed citizens of the new nation.

The Carroll family's impact extended beyond politics. Charles' cousin, John Carroll, became the first Archbishop of the United States and helped establish the foundations of the Catholic Church in America. The Carroll family was also among the Catholic families who preserved and supported the faith in Maryland during years of persecution, providing leadership, resources, and places where Catholics could gather and worship.

Charles Carroll lived to the age of 95 and became the last surviving signer of the Declaration of Independence. Looking back on a life marked by wealth, influence, and public service, he said that his greatest satisfaction was not found in any earthly achievement, but in the fact that he had faithfully "practiced the duties of my religion."

As we celebrate America's 250th birthday, may we remember the Catholics who helped build our nation and be inspired by their example of faith, service, and love of country. Like Charles Carroll, may we seek to place our relationship with God above all else and strive to leave a legacy of faith for future generations.

This week we are looking at the history of the Memorial Acclamation. The Memorial Acclamation was introduced into the Roman Rite following the reforms of the Second Vatican Council as part of the renewed emphasis on the active participation of the faithful in the Eucharistic Prayer. Drawing inspiration from ancient Eastern and Western liturgical traditions, it allows the congregation to proclaim the mystery of Christ's death, resurrection, and future coming immediately after the consecration. By giving voice to the assembly at this pivotal moment, the acclamation highlights the Church's response of faith to the saving work made present on the altar.

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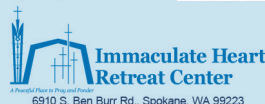
