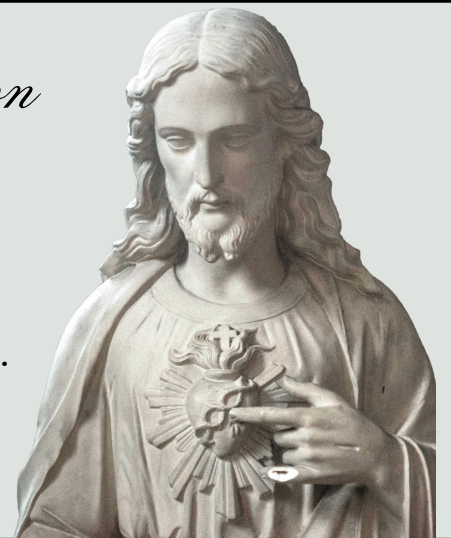

July 11 - 12: Olive Wood Artifacts from the Holy Land: This weekend, we will have beautiful handcrafted olive wood religious articles made by Christian families living in the Holy Land. These items will be sold before and after all the Masses in the vestibule or in the courtyard, depending on the weather. Please consider purchasing, as tourism has declined and Christian families are finding it more difficult to continue their woodworking businesses.

July 11 - 12: Fr. Peter's Celebration: Please join us in O'Malley Hall after the Sunday morning Masses for cake, pie, coffee, and juice as we thank him for his service and send him off with our gratitude and prayers.

July 14: Feast of St. Kateri Tekakwitha Mass. Please join us at 5:30 p.m. to celebrate the Feast of Saint Kateri Tekakwitha. Following Mass, there will be a relic procession and an opportunity to venerate the relic in the alcove beneath Saint Kateri's stained-glass window, where it will be displayed.
