A NOTE FROM FR. KRUSE

Dear Friends,

It's a joy and a blessing to be with you at St. Mary's Presentation! I'm a later vocation and was ordained by Bishop Daly on June 19, 2015. I'm the first diocesan priest he ordained—I remind him of that often. Over the years, I've served throughout the Diocese of Spokane in parish, university, and retreat ministries.

I grew up in San Diego, California. My parents are deceased, but I have a wonderful twin sister who lives in Spokane with her family, and a younger sister who lives in Portland, Oregon, with her family. I have seven nieces and nephews who sometimes still call me Uncle Father David. Prior to becoming a Catholic priest, I served in U.S. Army Special Operations and was stationed at Fort Bragg, North Carolina. I'm a combat veteran of the Iraq War. After my military service, I worked for several years as an independent contractor doing military and interrogation work for the federal government.

Prior to the Army, I taught instrumental music at the college and high school levels. My dream was to become a symphony conductor. However, the events of 9/11 and the ensuing war threw a monkey wrench in those plans—God's providence at work. I graduated from Grossmont College, Gonzaga University, and The Catholic University of America. My undergraduate work was in music, philosophy, and history. My graduate work was in business and theology.

In my free time, I enjoy spending time with friends and family, camping, photography, snowboarding, and riding motorcycles. I love being a priest of Jesus Christ. It's been the greatest blessing—and challenge—of my life. Please keep me in your prayers and be assured of mine. I look forward to accompanying you on this next leg of our adventure together as we make our way to heaven, our eternal home!
