Most Holy Virgin Mary, pray for us.

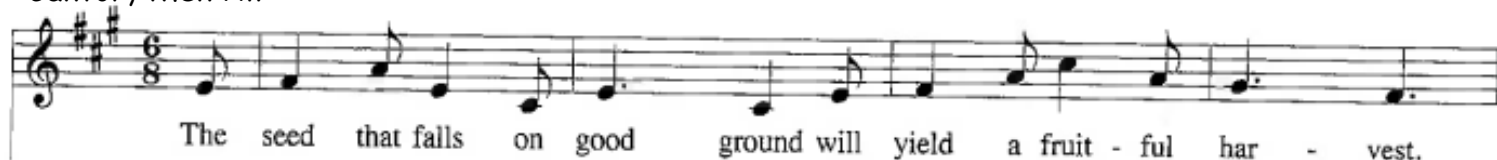

Our Lady of Fatima's 3rd Apparition

On July 13, 1917, Our Lady appeared to the three shepherd children at Fatima and entrusted them with one of her most urgent messages. She briefly allowed them to see a vision of hell, where they witnessed the suffering of souls. She told them that many souls go there because there is no one to pray and make sacrifices for them. Moved by this vision, the children devoted themselves even more fervently to prayer and acts of sacrifice.

Our Lady urged the daily praying of the Rosary, devotion to her Immaculate Heart, and lives of conversion and penance for the salvation of souls and for peace in the world. Her message remains a loving invitation for each of us to pray, trust in God's mercy, and help lead others to Christ.

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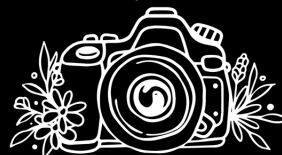
