Kelly Hughes – Country Grit, Rock Roots, Faith-Fueled Journey

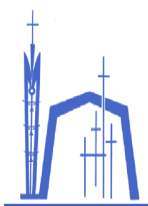

The Pastor's Corner

Dear Friends in Christ,

There are days when we kneel down to pray and simply don't know what to say. The words won't come, or the burden feels too heavy, too tangled, too far beyond us to put into a sentence. Saint Paul knew this struggle well. In Romans 8:26-27 (our second reading) he offers us one of the most comforting truths in all of Scripture: "the Spirit helps us in our weakness, for we do not know how to pray as we ought, but that very Spirit intercedes with sighs too deep for words."

We don't have to have the right words. God looks into the heart, not at our eloquence. When we come before Him tired, confused, or empty-handed, the Holy Spirit takes what we cannot say and carries it to the Father on our behalf. Prayer, then, isn't a performance — it's a surrender.

This is also why praying as a community matters so much. When one of us is too weary to pray, another can carry that intention forward. Our parish family lifts each other up, and the Spirit weaves all those prayers — spoken and unspoken — into something greater than any of us could offer alone.

And here's the invitation this week: look around you. Ask God to open your eyes to where He's already at work — a friend's unexpected kindness, a burden lifted, a reconciliation you thought impossible. Miracles are often quiet. But they are there, all around us, for those willing to see.

Let's keep praying for one another, trusting the Spirit to do what we cannot.

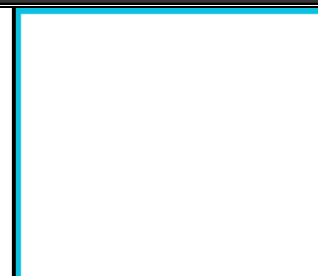
