MUSIC CORNER

Following up on our discussion of Sacred Music and what defines it, the Church teaches that singing the texts of the Mass—the dialogues, prayers, acclamations, and responses—adds a special solemnity to the liturgy because the rites themselves are given musical expression. Musicam Sacram explains that when the ministers and faithful sing the Mass together, the unity of the assembly is more clearly expressed and hearts are more readily lifted to God. Chanting the liturgy reminds us that the Mass is not an ordinary gathering, but a sacred encounter with Christ, where even our speech is elevated into prayer.

St. Mary Magdalene - Apostle to the Apostles

She remained with Him through the sorrow of the Crucifixion, was among the first to discover the empty tomb, and became the first to encounter the risen Lord.

Her life is a beautiful testimony that repentance, redemption, and faithful discipleship can transform a heart and lead others to Christ.
