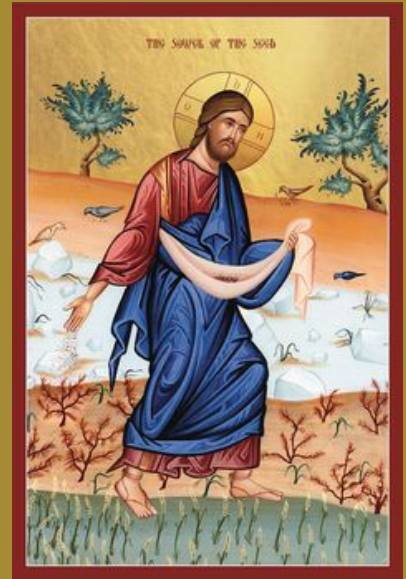

SAINT MARY MAGDALENE

feast day on July 22

On Easter morning, Mary Magdalene discovered that Jesus' body had disappeared. Words could not express her complex feelings at this time. Maybe a sense of helplessness: "They took my Lord away." Perhaps a sense of frustration: "Just tell me where you put my Lord's body."

Maybe a sense of guilt: "I should have stayed by the tomb last night." The tormented experience on Good Friday had worn her out completely, and then the body of Jesus missing completely overthrew her very last hope and belief.

Mary Magdalene was crying her eyes out in front of the empty tomb and did not realize that Jesus was standing behind her, waiting. He first called her, "Woman!" and she turned around. Yet, she did not recognize Jesus because she was still suffering excruciating pain. He called her again: "Mary!" Like a wake-up call, she turned to him and promptly responded, "Rabbouni!" After consoling her, Jesus commissioned her to announce his Resurrection to the disciples.

What if Mary Magdalene did not turn around? What if she was submerged deeply in her loss and pain and did not recognize Jesus' voice calling her? What if she kept looking at the empty tomb and missed the resurrected Christ was right behind her?

Furthermore, it is not easy to understand fully why Jesus chose to open the eyes and ears of Mary Magdalene and asked her to announce his resurrection to the disciples. This profound passage gave us some other ways to follow Jesus more closely. Like Mary Magdalene, turning around is not enough; we have to turn towards Jesus to be able to recognize him and listen to him. "I have called you by name." Mary Magdalene knew that very well. She could never be mistaken for the way, the tone of her beloved teacher's voice calling her. Only Jesus calls her that way. Just by that voice, nothing else matters. No need for an explanation. By hearing her name, Mary Magdalene promptly responded to Jesus, collapsed at his feet, and held them tight so that He could never be taken from her ever again. However, her mission was greater than that. Jesus chose her to be a person to announce His Resurrection to the disciples.

God's presence in our lives is often hidden. Amid the trials, misunderstandings, and ambiguities of daily living, God is there. Are we willing to let go of the past to live fully in the present? Are we learning how to love fully and freely without clinging or demanding certain results? Do we strive to develop our capacity to live in the present moment, and not to hang on to the painful past? Are we courageous enough to leave behind something that is known and familiar? Do we overcome our daily sadness and busyness to take time to turn around and look up to recognize Christ in those we encounter?
