Each day begins with Holy Mass, followed by full days of riding, shared meals, and time for reflection and conversation. The Men's Fellowship Motorcycle Ride is more than a trip—it is a pilgrimage on wheels, designed to foster brotherhood, spiritual renewal, and meaningful connections among men of faith, whether seasoned riders or those newer to long-distance touring. 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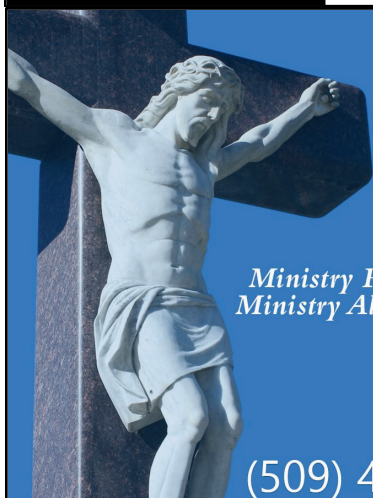
