PASTOR'S COLUMN

Bringing Back School Sisters

Last week, I provided some history about our parish convent and how we are working to restore and repair it. The plan is for Sister Francis Marie, our fifth-grade teacher, to live there together with other women who will join her new religious community.

Sister Francis Marie has been living at the rectory at St. Patrick Parish in Hillyard, which has not had a resident priest for several years. When she learned that St. Patrick Parish was to be merged with neighboring St. Francis Xavier Parish and have its property sold, she knew she would have to find a new home. Praying to God in search for a new place, one of her basic refrains was, "All I ask, Lord, is for *a little portion*."

There was additional pressing need because Sister had been working closely with a discernor on the cusp of entering. Would she have to delay her entrance due to inadequate housing? Eventually, the possibility of moving to the St. Charles convent came up. When Sister visited the space for the first time, she encountered a seemingly strong signal grace: Sister Patricia's sign for the apostolate she ran from her office in the convent building – *The Little Portion*.

Meanwhile, doors continued to open. A significant donor from outside the parish community came to support the restoration project, even going as far as personally looking for dignified yet cost-effective furnishings for the convent. Other donors have come forward as well from across the diocese. Also, the asbestos abatement came in at less than a third of the cost we were bracing for.

Having Sr. Francis Marie's fledgling community on our parish campus seems apt. Saint Charles Borromeo built the first seminaries to bolster the formation of priests. Sister's community is being established specifically to support the longevity of priests through spiritual intercession and by assisting them in the work of Catholic education. May the prayers of St. Charles Borromeo help build up not only a physical space, but a fruitful religious community!

I intend to donate personally to this project. If you are also excited by the prospect of having school sisters living on campus again, I encourage you to use the instructions found in this bulletin to give your own *little portion*.

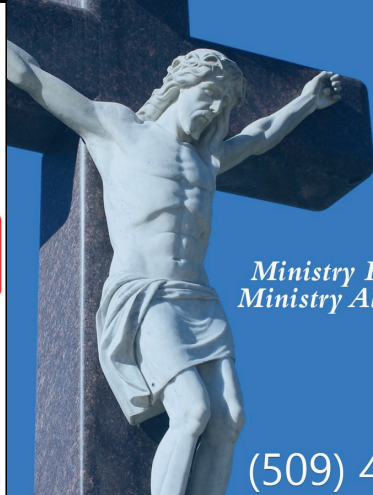
