Matthew Nicks, this week long experience invites Catholic men to deepen their faith while enjoying the camaraderie and freedom of motorcycle touring. Each day begins with Holy Mass, followed by full days of riding, shared meals, and time for reflection and conversation. The Men's Fellowship Motorcycle Ride is more than a trip—it is a pilgrimage on wheels, designed to foster brotherhood, spiritual renewal, and meaningful connections among men of faith, whether seasoned riders or those newer to long-distance touring. This year's destination is South Dakota, where participants will explore the scenic beauty of the Black Hills and Badlands, including winding mountain roads, wide open landscapes, and notable landmarks along the way.
