St. Augustine Music Program

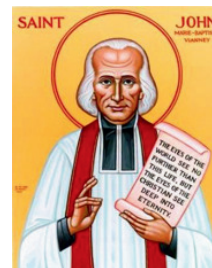

**Saint Alphonsus Liguori, Bishop
& Doctor of the Church**
Feast Day ~ August 1

Saint Alphonsus Liguori, was an Italian Catholic bishop, spiritual writer, composer, musician, artist, poet, lawyer, scholastic philosopher, and theologian. He founded the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer, known as the Redemptorists, in November 1732.

A prolific writer, among his best known works are *The Glories of Mary* and *The Way of the Cross*, the latter still used in parishes during Lenten devotions. One of the most widely read Catholic authors, he is the patron saint of confessors.

Saint John Marie-Baptiste Vianney was a French Catholic priest celebrated for his profound spiritual influence and dedication to the sacrament of confession. He is the patron saint of parish priests and is known for his extraordinary ability to counsel and convert people through his ministry in the confessional.

The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy

"Thus says the LORD: All you who are thirsty, come to the water!...I will renew with you the everlasting covenant..."

Isaiah 55:1, 3

"You have given us, O Lord, bread from heaven, endowed with all delights and sweetness in every taste."

Wisdom 16:20

These scriptures, from today's Old Testament reading and the Communion Antiphon, respectively, find a parallel in the texts for the two Communion hymns embedded in today's prelude: "Adoro te, devote," and "At That First Eucharist." In combining these two hymns, the composer—Lynn Trapp (b. 1963)—has created a sacred equivalent to what the Urban Dictionary calls a "mash-up." The postlude—*Sortie (Alleluia)*, by Jean-Jacques Grunenwald (1911-1972)—also combines snippets of two themes: "Adoro te, devote," and the Eastertide *Ite missa est*. Jubilation finds its voice amidst the increasingly discordant sounds. For more information, please ask our music director, Heather Fuller-Johnson, or our organist, Joseph Schubert.

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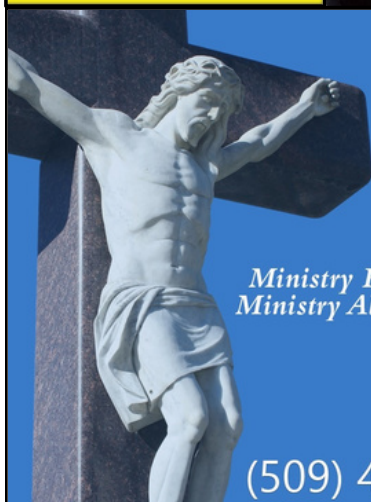


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
