THE KEYS OF THE KINGDOM

In today's Gospel, Jesus asks His disciples who they believe He is. Simon Peter boldly professes, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." Jesus then names Peter the rock upon which He will build His Church and gives him the keys to the Kingdom of Heaven.

The image of the keys would have been familiar in ancient times. When a king traveled or was away from his kingdom, he would entrust its keys to the person appointed to govern in his absence. In the same way, Christ entrusted Peter with a unique authority to shepherd His Church until his return.

Jesus tells Peter: **"I will give you the keys of the Kingdom of Heaven. Whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven."** (Matthew 16:19)

Today, we continue to recognize the Pope, successor of St. Peter and holder of the keys of the Kingdom of Heaven, as the visible shepherd of Christ's Church. The Church remains firmly grounded in Peter's confession of faith: **Jesus Christ is Lord.**

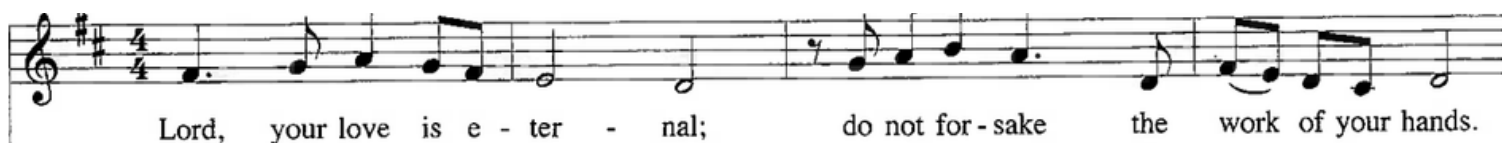


A PRAYER FOR THE HOLY FATHER

MUSIC CORNER

The Church does not expect everyone at Mass to sing every word; rather, she gives different parts of the liturgy to different members of the assembly. Musicam Sacram describes a "hierarchy" of participation in sung worship, with the priest, ministers, choir, and congregation each having their proper parts, while the General Instruction of the Roman Missal gives particular importance to the dialogues and acclamations shared between priest and people. This diversity is not a limitation on participation but an expression of the Church's liturgical order: the priest proclaims and prays in the name of the Church, the assembly responds with acclamations and prayer, and the choir or schola fulfills its own musical ministry. When each part is carried out faithfully, many voices and ministries come together as one act of worship.
