Dear St. Aloysius Parishioners,

Grace and peace to you through the Sacred Heart of Jesus. This year's Annual Catholic Appeal (ACA) theme, "A Heart that Never Fails," could not be more fitting. Through every season — joyful and difficult alike — the Sacred Heart of Jesus has sustained us. It sustains our parish too, through your prayer, your presence, and your generosity.

I am grateful for the generosity and spirit that continue to make our parish a vibrant community of faith. Whether through Sunday tithing, support of St. Al's Grade School, gifts to our Preservation Fund, or participation in events such as the Parish Picnic or volunteer work, your participation matters.

This year, I would like to place a special importance on that word: participation.

Last year, St. Aloysius exceeded our ACA goal of **\$215,481**. Because of your generosity, approximately **\$23,725** will be returned to St. Aloysius to support this year's parish operating budget. I am grateful to everyone who contributed.

However, only about **30%** of our parish households participated in the ACA last year.

As a growing parish of approximately **1,773+** registered families, I believe we can do better—not simply by asking the same families to give more, but by asking more of us to participate.

Our 2026 ACA assessment is **\$226,915**. If each of our **1,773** parish families gave approximately **\$128.00** before Thanksgiving, our entire ACA assessment would be met.

That is **\$42.66** per month for three months.

Some families may be able to give more than that. Others may not be able to give that amount. That is okay. What I hope we can accomplish this year is greater participation throughout our parish. Every gift, regardless of its size, matters!

The ACA supports the work of the Catholic Diocese of Spokane, including diocesan ministries and operations. It provides important assistance to smaller parishes and ministries throughout Eastern Washington that cannot fully support themselves.

I ask that you please continue your regular support of St. Aloysius through your Sunday tithing and, when possible, through gifts to St. Al's Grade School, our Preservation Fund, and our parish endowment. These gifts directly support the ministries, facilities, staff, school, and future of our parish.

This year, let's make the Annual Catholic Appeal something we accomplish together.

1,773 families. \$128 per family. Three months. One parish.
