Sacrosanctum Concilium calls the faithful to participate "fully conscious and active," but it also specifically encourages moments of sacred silence, during which we listen, meditate, and unite our hearts to what is being celebrated. Musicam Sacram likewise recognizes the important place of silence in the liturgy. Sometimes our most profound participation is not singing or speaking, but listening attentively, entering into silence, and allowing the prayer of the Church to become our own prayer.

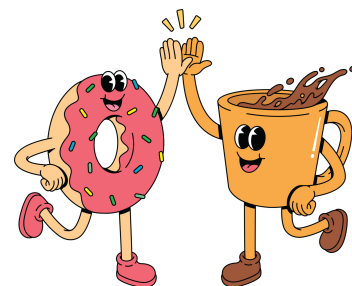


Mission Statement
