Most Holy Virgin Mary, pray for us.

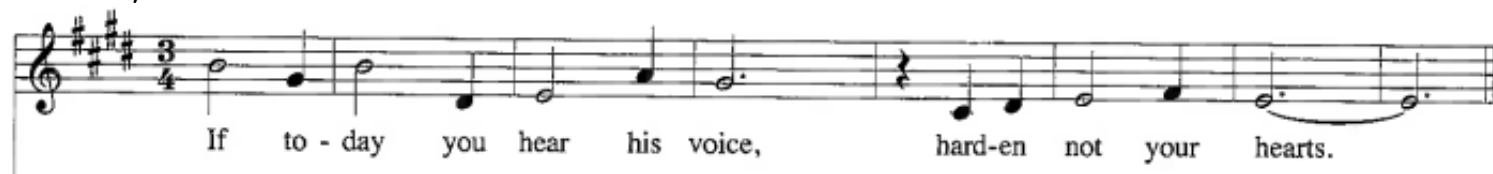

MUSIC CORNER

The choir has a distinctive ministry within the liturgy: it does not simply provide music for the congregation, but serves the worship of the entire Church. Sacrosanctum Concilium recognizes the choir as having a genuine liturgical role, while Musicam Sacram explains that the choir may sing parts belonging properly to it while also helping the faithful participate through song. Sing to the Lord similarly describes the choir as serving the assembly by leading, supporting, and enriching its sung prayer. The choir's ministry, therefore, is not meant to replace the voice of the congregation, but to strengthen it—sometimes by leading us in song, and sometimes by giving voice to the Church's prayer on our behalf while we listen, meditate, and pray. 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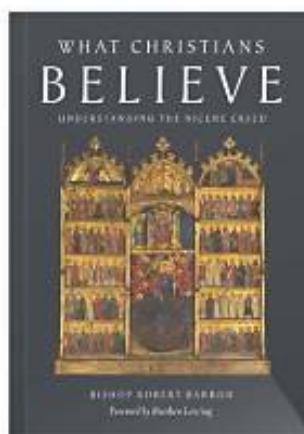

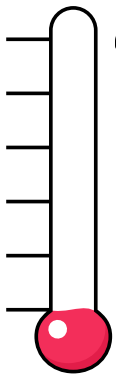
