Sunday Reflection

Friends, as we reflect on our readings for this Third Sunday in Lent, I want us also to be reminded of how privileged we are this year to have Catechumens; Abby Kelly, Ali Duhrkoop, Jared Ford, Chad Witherspoon, Conrad Manfred, Margaret Kelly and Candidates, Autumn Drescher, and Sarah Manfred who will be received, baptized and Confirmed in the Catholic faith on Easter Vigil. Together as a community we pray for them as they continue on this very important journey of faith. The central theme for the readings this Sunday is "Thirst". The Israelites in the first reading grumble against Moses because they are thirsty for water in the desert, and Jesus in the Gospel asks for water from the Samaritan woman to quench his thirst.

For Jesus to encounter the Samaritan woman in the way he did, was a violation of a number of social norms. She was a Samaritan; He was a Jew. She was a woman; He was a man. She was five times married, well beyond the moral limit in her culture, and living with a man who was not her husband! Jesus was a renown Rabbi, and association with such a woman was never permissible. No wonder, when His disciples returned from their journey in search for food, they were scandalized to find our Lord conversing with this woman.

Jesus neither rejected, avoided, nor condemned the Samaritan woman. What Jesus saw in this woman, is a thirsty soul yearning to be loved, understood, to be given hope, and meaning in her life, to be shown mercy and compassion. That's why He promises to give her Living water that she may never be thirsty again. With patience and deeper understanding, Jesus dialogued and accepted her as she was. This must have helped the Samaritan woman, to grow in self-knowledge and later sparked in her a desire to share her experience with the Lord to the broader community. What Jesus teaches us here, is the great effect patience, acceptance, compassion, truth, and love can have on people even when their past has been unpleasant.

Perhaps our brothers and sisters who will be received and baptized in our faith this Easter would not have made that bold decision in their lives, to join the Catholic faith if they did not feel welcomed, loved, accepted and above all understood in our community or in the communities of faith where they first got a thought to become Catholics. I firmly believe it was the warm reception they received from their first encounters that led them to make this conclusion in their spiritual journey. I have no doubt, many people out there thirst to be accepted, understood, loved, and be led to the truth, but many times we scare them off with our judgements or condemnations.

Therefore, this Lenten season is an opportunity for us to pray for God's grace to open our hearts to be more patient, seek to understand those around us instead of pointing fingers, show more compassion in place of cold-heartedness, and be more accepting of others, just as we all want to be accepted or loved. Let us also pray for a deeper thirst for the truth, and lead others to the same. Humanly speaking we thirst for mere water but our Lord thirsts for souls and we are called to quench his thirst by leading many souls to Him.


